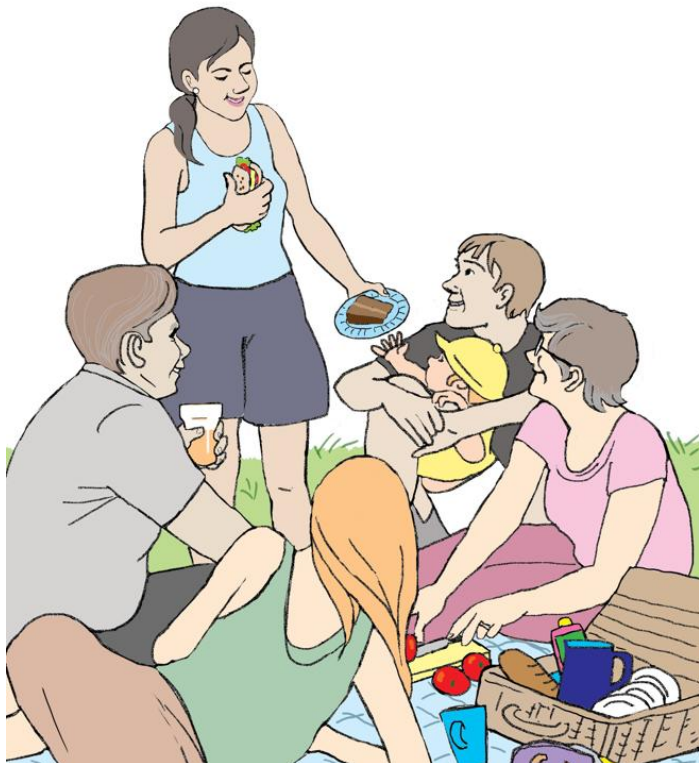


Development Lead (Small Supports) c£45k

Not a traditional care role - help us build relationship-based support in Surrey



Let's Belong is looking for the right person to help develop support that enables people with learning disabilities to live well and belong in their own communities.

This is not about fitting people into existing services. It is about building support around the person. This is a practical role as well as a development opportunity.

The work will begin with supporting a specific man with learning disabilities to build a strong, relationship-based support arrangement in his local area. Alongside this, we want to develop a wider model of support that can become available to other people in Surrey using direct payments or personal budgets.

We want to hear from you if you believe support should be: built through real relationships *

shaped around ordinary life, not service routines * flexible, local and person-led * developed with families and people who know the person well

creative, thoughtful and practical * strong enough to manage complexity without becoming restrictive

This may suit you if you are:

- an experienced practitioner, team leader or manager in learning disability/autism support
- good at your work, but frustrated by traditional care models
- able to build trust slowly and respectfully
- practical enough to coordinate support, but reflective enough to challenge systems
- interested in helping build something better locally in Surrey

How this could work

With the right person, involvement could begin as soon as September or October. We are open to part-time or full-time employment, phased involvement, consultancy, secondment or another flexible arrangement.

We are not beginning with a formal application form or conventional interview process. We are starting with conversations. If there seems to be a good fit, we will share an information pack and arrange an initial video conversation. Remuneration will reflect the seniority, experience and responsibility required, and will be as strong as we can reasonably afford.
