- *Shared learning about flexible, person-led support

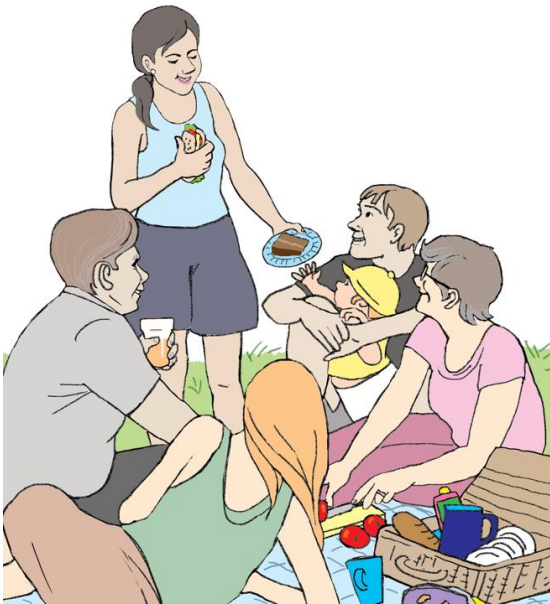


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What we are trying to create

- support shaped around the person, not existing service routines
- support that builds on families, friendships, community and what already works
- local support, community connections and paid support where needed
- robust coordination, management and oversight
- a small relationship-based support model available to others in Surrey over time

How we are starting

We are starting with conversations. If there seems to be shared purpose, we will share an information pack and arrange an initial video conversation. Any partnership, secondment or collaboration would need clear governance, safeguarding, accountability and practical agreement before proceeding.
